Entry procedure 2018 European Junior Cycling Tour Assen

The Jeugdtoer Assen is a very popular event. In recent years the youth categories were fully booked in minutes. We also saw that the amount of British participants grew explosively in recent years: from 20% in 2014 tot 34% in 2017. That is a 60% increase.

To regain the international character of the event, we will have to cap the participation per country per category. To establish these maximum amounts, the entry process will be different.

You can enter from 5 February 2018 at 10am CET. The entry form will then appear on the website. Fill in all the required details meticulously. The entry form will be online for two weeks, or longer if the category is not full yet.

After completing the entry form online, you will receive a confirmation email with all the data you provided for the application. **This is not a confirmation of entry, it's a confirmation that you applied for a start place in this year's event.**

Check your spam inbox and add info@ejcta.nl to your address book.

Every application gets a unique number. This number is based on the sequence of entering. The speed of your application is still the main factor to get a place in the race. It's first comes, first served. It is not a draw.

Based on the individual number and the nationality quatum, start places will be allotted. From 19 February, but probably much faster in the youth categories that fill up fast, participants will receive an email with information on how to pay. The payment must be in our account before the 1st of April. After we received the entry fee, the participation has been confirmed.

From 19 February, but in many cases faster, the names of those riders who were allotted a start place will appear on the website. After payment of the entry fee, they will also receive a bib number. Before the bib numbers are awarded the names on the website are in alphabetical order.

In case places become vacant because of cancellation or not paying on time, they will be given to the first rider on the original application list, regardless of nationality. This is our waiting list. Applying for a waiting list via email has no purpose.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I entered in the wrong category

It is always your own responsibility to enter the rider in the correct category. The list is on our website. However, if you make a mistake, re-enter the rider as soon as possible. If the required category is full by that time, the rider won't be able to start.

I have several kids and not everyone got in

Because of the popularity of the event, we can't take factors like multiple kids in one family or club, into account. We try to keep the registration as honest as possible and only select by sequence number and nationality.

Cancellation for this reason is free until 1 April.

Cancellation

From 2018 cancellation is not free anymore, except if done before 1 April. Because on average 6% and in 2017 almost 10% cancelled too late or not at all and we couldn't redistribute those start places in time, we will not reimburse fully. We have already made our investments for the event and the campsite.

Cancellation before 1 May: 80% restitution

Cancellation before 1 June: 60% restitution

Cancellation before 1 July: 40% restitution

Cancellation before 30 July: 20% restitution

Cancellation is only possible via info@ejcta.nl. The above mentioned rules also apply to the campsite.

Cancellation is free of charge until the first of April.

When and how do I pay?

When you have a start place you will receive a confirmation email. The payment details are in that email. To secure the start place, you have to pay before the 1st of April. If you enter later in a still available category, please pay before the event or at the start.

When and how do I reserve a place on the campsite?

Please wait until after confirmation of your start place before booking our campsite. You can book our campsite via our website.

My name is on the website but I didn't get a confirmation email

If your name is on the website, you have a start place. This is an automated process: a push of a button. The confirmation emails are sent manually and might take a bit longer.

We will start allotting the places in the youth categories as soon as possible.

I am not on the start list

If your name is not on the online entry list by 1 March, you don't have a start place in the race. We will not inform non-starters personally.

This doesn't apply to categories that are still open on 1 March like, mostly, category 1 and junior-men.

We understand it is sad if you can't start the race because it is such a great event. However, we only have limited space available in the race due to safety regulations and practical reasons: time, space, manpower etc.
